Pushchairs

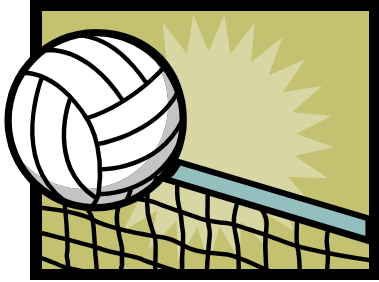
Please can we remind you that pushchairs are not allowed in school. There is a covered area near the office to store buggies. Thank you for your help with this.
