On **Wednesday 14th November** the Federation will be taking part in a radio broadcast presented by Eastbourne Youth Radio. Roselands and Stafford school will be provided with an hour slot on the radio show and children from across both schools will be involved in preparing songs, interviews and presentations for the broadcast.

The theme for this year's broadcast is encouraging respect, celebrating a love for music and highlighting an awareness of anti-bullying. As a federation, we feel that it is important that all children are engaged with preparation for the broadcast and we are strongly encouraging all children to embrace the theme. Therefore, on this day both schools will be holding an afternoon of music celebration to enrich children's learning, understanding and appreciation of music. To fully embrace the day, children are encouraged to come to school dressed as a musical idol or a festival attendee. This choice enables your child to dress as a musician they aspire to be or simply wear welly boots and jeans just as a festival attendee would when appreciating music! If your child is chosen to represent the school at the radio station they will, however, need to wear their uniform or bring it with them to change into as they will be representing the school.
