Year 2 Term 4 Drusillas Trip Letter

Dear Parents/Carers,

On **Tuesday 2nd April**, to celebrate our **Rainforest Topic**, Year 2 will be going to **Drusillas Park** for the day. We will be travelling on 2 coaches fitted with seatbelts, leaving school at approximately 9:15am and returning to school by 3pm. You can bring your children to school and collect them as you would on a normal school day but please note they may be slightly late back due to traffic.

The children will need:

- **School uniform**, though trainers may be more suitable for the adventure play area
- A packed lunch with a drink in a **named** container
- A drink in a watertight *plastic* container (**no glass please**)
- A named **waterproof** coat - *the weather may change during the day*
- A named **sunhat**
- **Suncream** if the weather is hot. Please apply this in the morning before school. Most suncreams are now suitable to be applied first thing in the morning to last all day.

Spending money will not be needed as we will not be visiting the shop. If you would like your child to have a packed lunch made by the school kitchen, please indicate this on the form below. During the day, children will have the opportunity to learn about over 134 animals and their habitats, find out about conservation issues, take part in a 'Rainforest' educational session and use the adventure play areas. We would be most appreciative of any offers to help supervise small groups of children for the day. As coach space is limited and in order to keep costs down, we are looking for volunteers to drive adult helpers to and from Drusillas on the day. Please see your child's class teacher if you can help in any way as soon as possible.

TRIP COSTS:

The total voluntary contribution for the trip will be **£12.00 per child**. This will cover coach travel, insurance, entrance to the zoo and an educational session about rainforests. If your child has a membership card, we are asking for a voluntary contribution of £5 to cover the cost of the coach and the rainforest education session but **we will need their membership card in school on Tuesday 2nd April**. Please note that if we don't receive enough funds to cover the cost of the trip, then unfortunately it will be cancelled. **Please complete the attached form to give your consent for this trip and return it to school by Thursday 21st March**.
